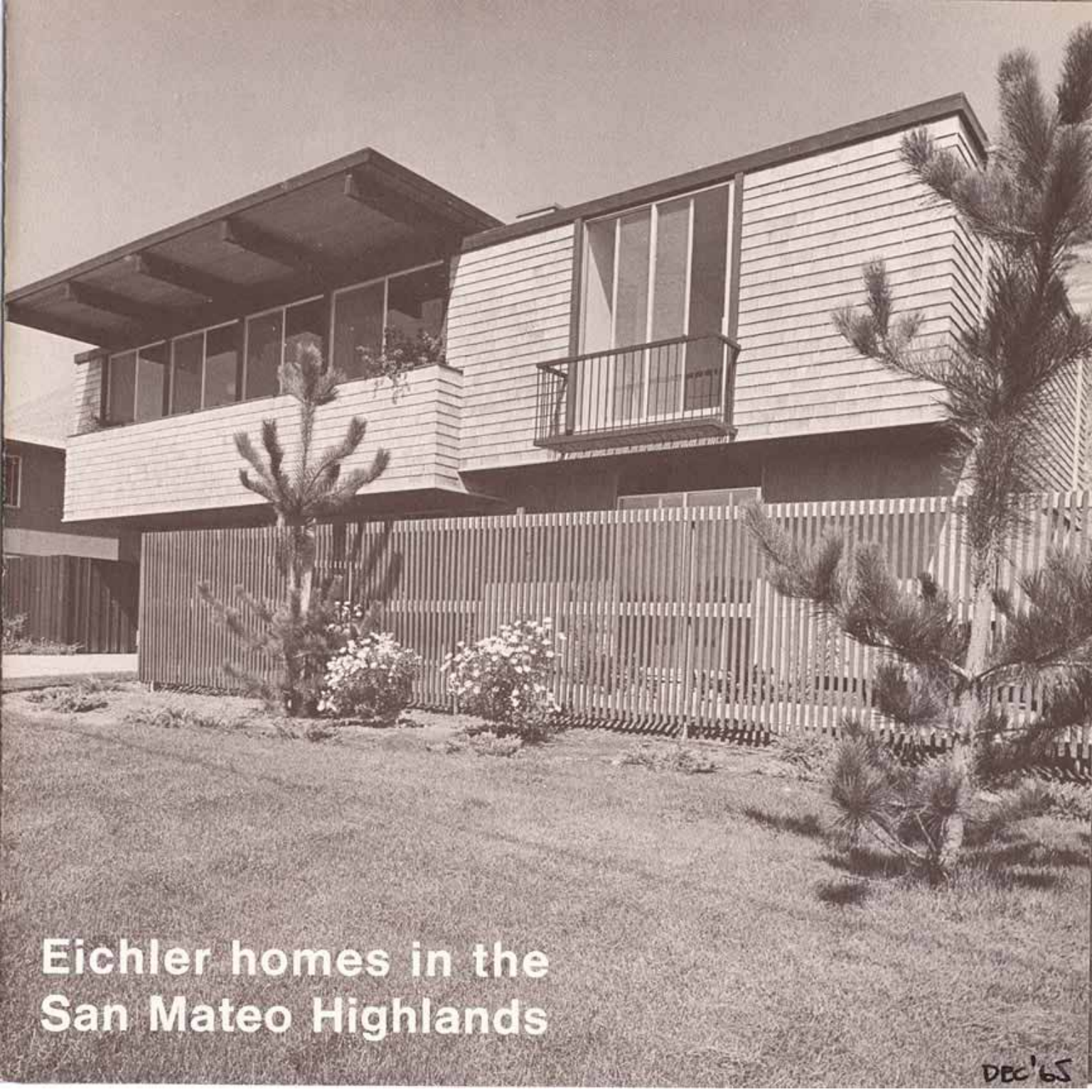

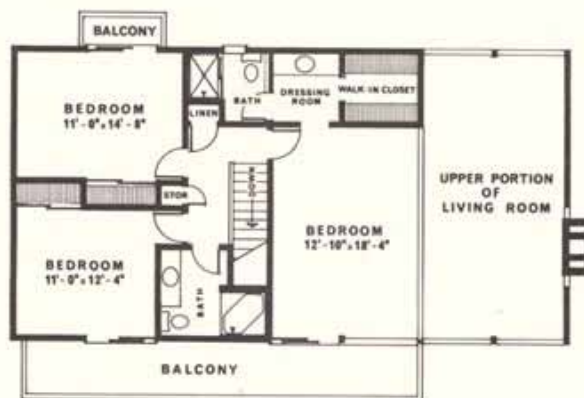

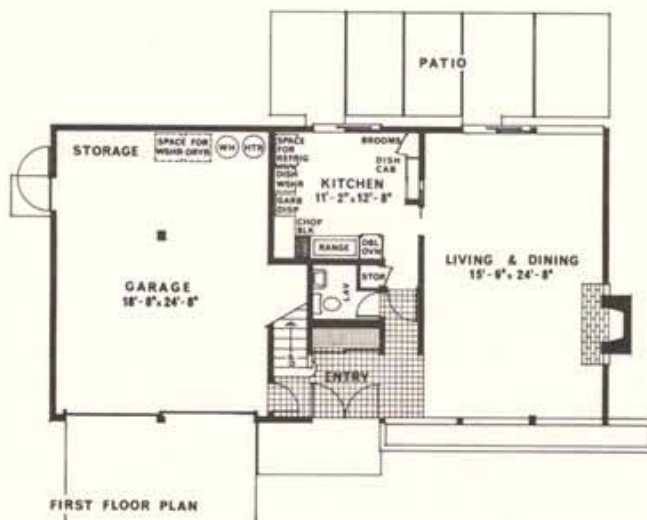
SECOND FLOOR PLAN

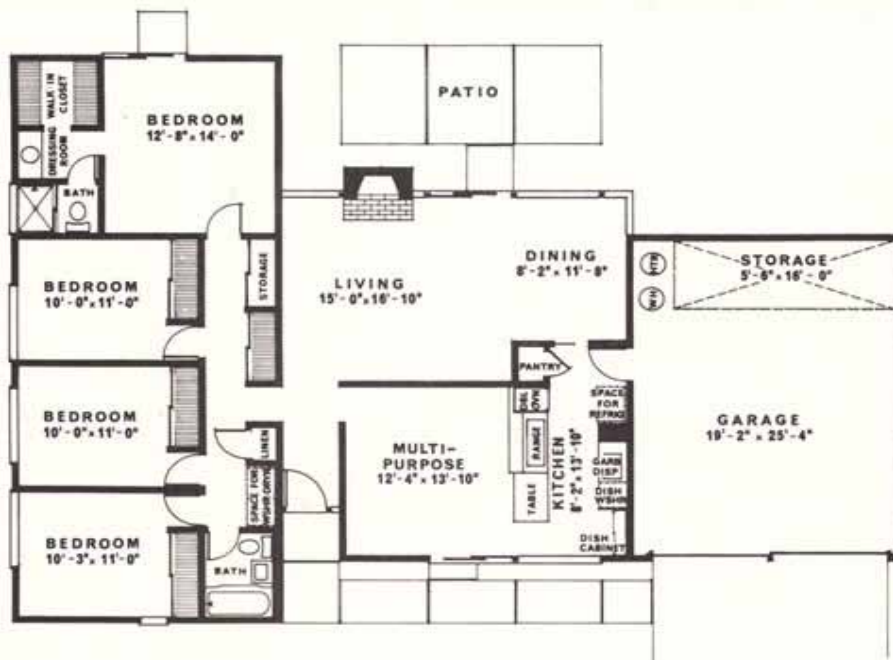
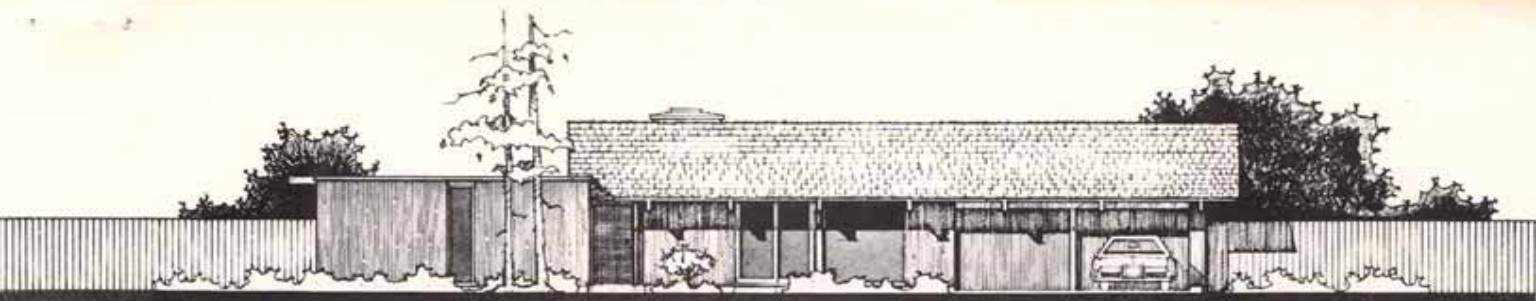
